Tom Knaub has donated 100 pounds of top quality, frozen Alaskan Halibut that he caught (valued at \$30 per pound) to raise funds for the Nancy Martin Memorial Scholarship Fund.

HOW TO GET HALIBUT?

With a generous donation to the Nancy Martin Fund, we are happy to provide you a package(s) of frozen Halibut (1.5-2 pounds) when you leave the fish fry or to be picked up at a later time.

WHY SUPPORT THE NANCY MARTIN FUND?

Nursing students in Nazareth are predominantly Palestinian Israelis and many face financial challenges. The Nancy Martin Memorial Scholarship Fund was created by the Nazareth Project in 2019 after the passing of Nancy to supply scholarship funding for lower-income and high-achieving students at the School.

At 6:30pm Tom Knaub will share about his experience fishing for halibut in Alaska with his grandson, Thomas Chittenden, earlier this summer. Before his fishing trip he told his friend Bob Martin that he wanted to donate his catch to Nancy's fund.
